ORDINANCE No. 206, OF SEPTEMBER 4, 2018

Provides for mandatory quotation of CAPES

THE PRESIDENT OF THE COORDINATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF HIGHER-LEVEL PERSONNEL, in the use of the powers conferred on him by art. 26th of the Statute, approved by Decree No. 8977, of 01/30/2017, and CONSIDERING what is indicated in the CAPES Notices, in the Scholarship Commitment Terms, in the regulations of scholarships abroad and scholarships in the country, in the AUXPE Manual, and in the term of adhesion to the Portal de Periódicos; CONSIDERING what is contained in the case file No. 23038.013648/2018-51, resolves:

- Art. 1st The works produced or published, in any media, resulting from activities financed, in whole or in part, by CAPES, must, obligatorily, make reference to the support received.
- Art. 2nd For the purpose of identifying the funding source, the use of code 001 is authorized for all funding received.
- Art. 3rd The following expressions must be used, in the language of the work:
- "The present work was carried out with the support of the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel Brazil (CAPES)
- Financing Code 001
- "This study was financed in part by the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel Brazil (CAPES) Finance Code 001"
- Art. 4th The dean for post-graduation studies or similar is responsible for the dissemination and application of the rule within the Higher Education Institutions that receive support from CAPES.
- Art. 5th Failure to comply with this standard will result in eventual changes in CAPES support for the institutions and researchers involved, starting in 2020.
- Art. 6th This Ordinance enters into force on the date of its publication.
